#### Breakfast

### Travel to Meribel from the U.K.

#### By Air

Geneva, Lyon, Grenoble and Chambéry airports are all approximately 2 hours from the resort with regular scheduled flights available to these airports including Easy Jet. [www.easyjet.com](http://www.easyjet.com)

The resort is approximately 600 miles from the channel ports and is conveniently served by motorway to within 12 miles of the resort.

#### By train
