Walking in Meribel

Whether your idea of walking in the mountains is a gentle ramble or a three day hike, Méribel has something for you. The valley has hundreds of kilometres of beautiful, marked walking trails, some of which link up with the lifts, and a booklet of recommended circuits is available from the Tourist Office.

For the more adventurous, try longer hikes into the Vanoise National Park, perhaps staying overnight in a refuge. The local Mountain Guides Office offer guided group walks, walks on a glacier, and private, longer trips.

The Mountain Guides' Office offers a variety of guided outings, many in the national park. A weekly hiking programme is offered during July and August, with half, one and two-day treks. For the more adventurous, high mountain tours, rock climbing, canyoning and via ferrata are available. Children can also enjoy exploring the area: Les Castors Juniors' club offers children aged 6 to 12 an introduction to the mountains and nature.
